






Data and Information Access Service (DIAS)

Copernicus

- Imminent launch of a Data Access and Information Service (DIAS)
- Procurement of parallel services from five suppliers:
 - 5 platforms to provide equal access to the basic data and services
 - Run by 2 entrusted entities:
 EUMETSAT (1 platform) and ESA (4 platforms)
- Overall ensuring that Copernicus data is easily accessible and used!

New Copernicus data approach

Dual approach:

- 1. Strengthened Copernicus Distribution Services
 - Data available for download only \rightarrow 10 access points


- 2. Setting up several Data Access and Information Services (DIAS)
 - Access to all Copernicus data and information collocated with computing resources
 - Allowing Big Data analytics without the need to download the data and information
 - Allowing data fusion with non-EO data and information

The programme will award **50.000 euro to 20 European start-ups** every year, to finance their incubation in an incubation/acceleration supporting organisation of their choice .









Copernicus Hackathons





Caroline Herschel Framework Partnership Agreement (FPA)

Financial assistance for user uptake projects of Copernicus (increasing socioeconomic benefits, increasing demand for Copernicus data and information, promoting the use of Copernicus data and information, increasing market penetration etc.)

Three tiers:


- **Tier 1**: national user uptake (by national stakeholders), for e.g. awareness events, training sessions, online courses
- **Tier 2**: global actions (European cross-border user uptake and international user uptake)
- **Tier 3:** business solutions and innovative products and applications (supporting start-ups, incubations, lifting administrative barriers etc.)

Applications can only be submitted from legal entities established in Copernicus participating states

Consortium will comprise entities from different Copernicus States - announcement about the Consortium is expected next week






